

# IACC2026 REGISTRATION POLICY

By registering, please be aware that you agree to the registration policy outlined below.

## Registration fees and processing charges

Please note that these prices are in USD. All registration fees will be charged in USD.

## Paying with VISA or MasterCard via Stripe

Early bird registration is open. Please note that Early Bird tickets are limited.

- **Early Bird – Regular fee:** The amount charged to your card will be USD\$550.
- **Early Bird– Reduced fee** (for NGOs, academic institutions and students): The amount charged to your card will be USD\$300.
- **Regular fee:** The amount charged to your card will be USD\$650.
- **Reduced fee** (for NGOs, academic institutions and students): The amount charged to your card will be USD\$400.
- **Day pass** (covers access for only one day of your choice): The amount charged to you card will be USD\$200.

Early Bird registration at a discounted fee closes after 31 October 2026.

## Cancellation and Refund Policy

All registration cancellations must be received in writing via an email to [iaccregistration@transparency.org](mailto:iaccregistration@transparency.org).

**Full refund:** Notification must be provided in writing by, Saturday, 31 October 2026 before midnight CEST, via an email to [iaccregistration@transparency.org](mailto:iaccregistration@transparency.org). A full refund will be provided within 60 days; however, an administrative fee will be charged by Stripe.

All refunds will be processed within 2 months after the conclusion of the conference. All refunds will be issued back to the original payment form.

Any fees, charges, or processing costs imposed by the payment provider in connection with a refund request shall be borne in full by the participant requesting the refund.

**Do note that exchange rates fluctuations may take occur and the IACC organisers cannot take responsibility for such changes.**

All fees, charges, and processing costs applied by the payment provider are strictly non-refundable under any circumstances.

- Those with a day pass are entitled to attend all sessions for the registered date only.
- Each IACC participant is encouraged to obtain their own travel insurance and understand their individual visa requirements. The IACC organisers do not provide travel insurance nor provide support for visa requests processing other than general guidance.
- An email confirming your registration, with an additional email confirming your payment from Stripe will be sent to you after your payment is complete. - Each email address may only be used for one registration. The platform operates on a strict one-email-per-registrant basis to ensure account integrity, prevent duplicate or conflicting registrations, and maintain accurate user identification. This approach is implemented for security reasons and is also necessary to support compliance with applicable data protection and privacy regulations, including the proper management of user consent for communications and data processing.
